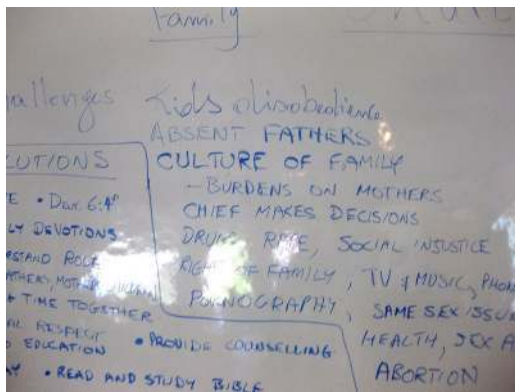
A new beginning for Fiji

The day sessions were divided into two groups with the youth having separate gatherings. Michael Maeliau led the young people in their first session. He spoke from Psalm 82 which proclaims God's judgment against the demonic princes who promote unrighteousness in a nation. They concluded by declaring Psalm 82:8 "Rise up, O God, judge the earth, for all the nations are your inheritance". This is quite significant since the redemptive calling for Fiji is Judgment. At the same time in the other gathering Luis Bush brought the challenge that a great nation was defined by knowing the presence of God and following his principles, (Deut.4:7-8). Some young people were present and were asked to stand in the center and be prayed over as the symbol of the establishment of this new generation in Fiji who would know the presence of God and follow his principles. After prayer and anointing the young people responded in a song of praise. One intercessor saw that heaven was open and that the glory of God was flowing from heaven and going right down into the land, and back to heaven.

Lillian Schmid led a number of workshops on transformation in the village of Lawai. Discussion and interaction with the participants that involved the issues which affected the Fijian Society in the area



of Family (Fatherless, husbands leaving their wives behind, kids disobedience, burden on mothers, chiefs making decisions on behalf of families, social injustice among people, sex abuse, pornography, homosexuality, health risks), proposal of solution followed by Praying to God to intervene with His power, provide education and counseling for kids, encourage bible study group in every home, support of women's needs, pastors to establish counseling sessions for men, devotions and prayers to break through the spirit of Belial which is affecting Christian families, recognize and pray against the strongholds of the enemy, community support groups, and fighting alcohol problems.



Challenges and Solutions for three major areas Family, Church and Marketplace lead by Lilian Schmid

Together we identified problems that are blocking the move of God in churches: competition between many churches and denominations, pastors drinking alcohol to excess, false attitudes, false religions, e.g. Buddhism and Islam, challenges between Christians, new ideas not embraced, elders following tradition more than scripture and not relying on the power of the Holy Spirit, need for more pastoral care, pride, false doctrine, hierarchy and separation between the pastors, intercessors and the congregation, bitterness between denominations. We prayed to break the division among the body of Christ and the power of religious spirits.

The churches need forgiveness and reconciliation among the body of Christ to bring peace and reconciliation between denominations, which also affects normal people. There is also a need for training on servant leadership, to change constitution of the Church, (Galatians 5:19-22) desire to see the fruits of the Holy spirit in the church, gifts of the Holy Spirit, and every person valued. Church to reconcile anointed leadership, engage women in ministry, recognition of lay ministers (Eph 4:11): *"It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers."*

Fijians want to see revival in the Church, let the Holy Spirit fire move, practicing the gifts of the Holy Spirit to bring real transformation, true teaching of the word, engage kids in ministry and prayer, youth groups and bible studies, and to let women lead.

We finished with prayers; the presence of the Holy Spirit was manifested mightily. Many of them bonded by praying and sharing their sorrows, and the real transformation started to breakthrough from within.
